I will learn maths and English every day.

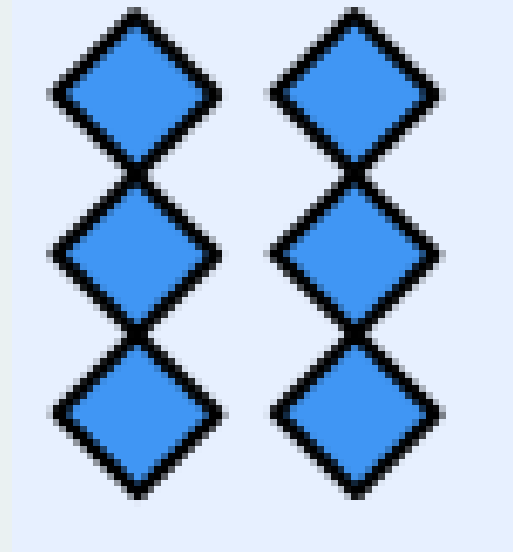
Break time and lunch times will be the same.

Things that might be different:

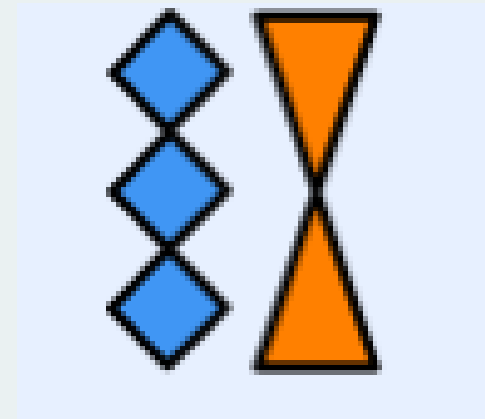
New classroom.

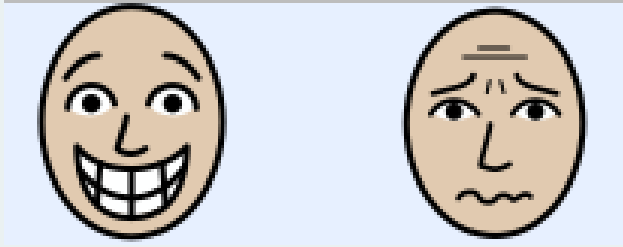
I might have a new talk partner.

I might have playtime in a different playground.

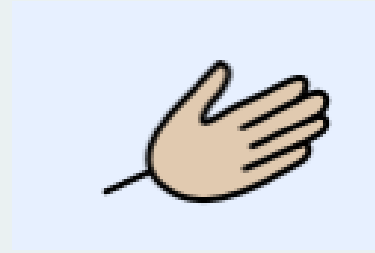
I may have new adults supporting me.





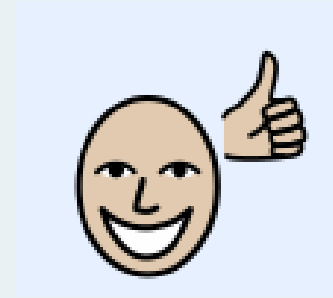
- Everyone feels excited and nervous when they are starting something new.
