## Glossary:

- **Circumnavigate** - sail or travel all the way around.
- **Privateer** - an armed ship owned and crewed by private individuals holding a government commission and authorized for use in war, especially in the capture of merchant shipping.
- **Knighted** - to give someone the rank of knight.
- **Sir Francis Drake** - was an English explorer and privateer.
- **Queen Elizabeth I** - was *Queen* of England and Ireland from 17 November 1558 until her death in 1603.
- **Elizabethan** - refers to the English history of Queen Elizabeth I's reign (1558-1603).
- **Golden Hind** - The ship Sir Francis Drake Circumnavigated the globe in.
- **Mayor** - the head of a town, borough, or county council, elected by council members and generally having purely ceremonial duties.

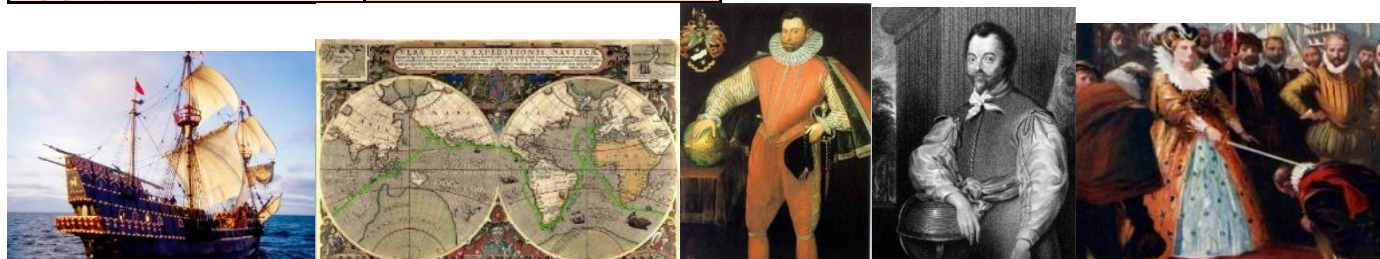
