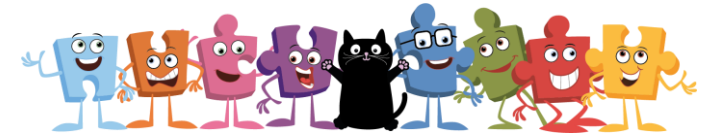














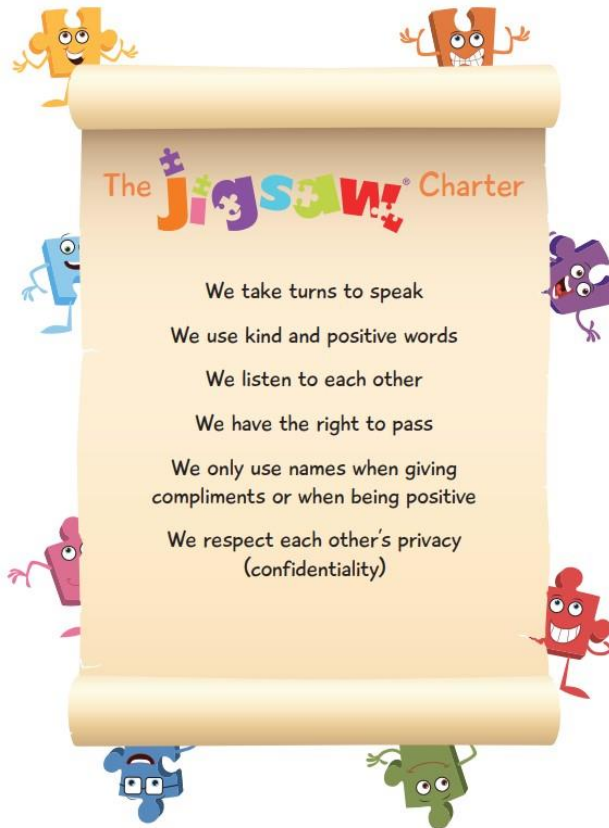


Year 2 Knowledge Organiser Celebrating Differences
