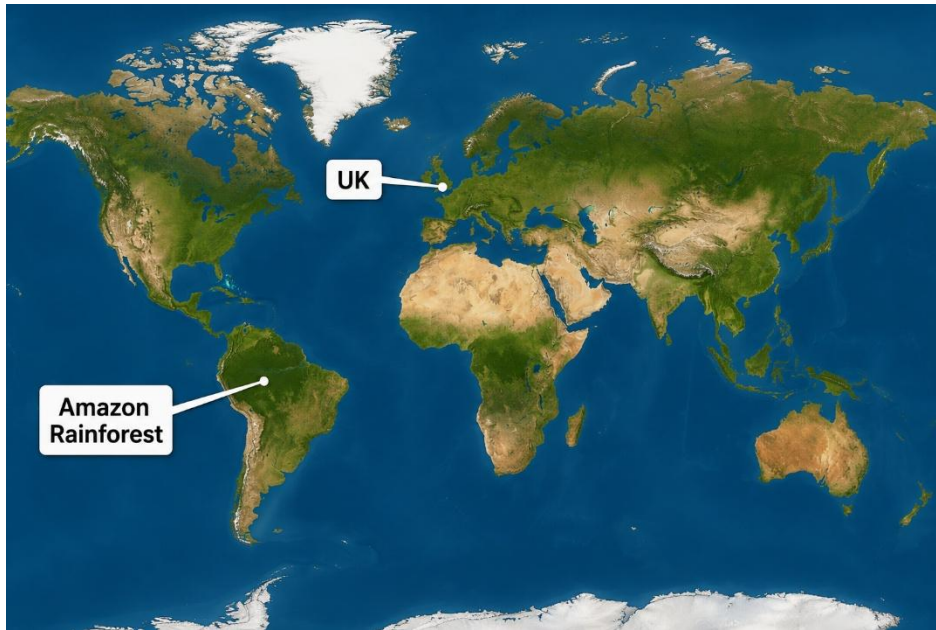


# Year 1/2 Geography - Summer 2 - The Amazon Rainforest.

Vocabulary	
Valley 	A valley is a long, low area of land that sits between hills or mountains. It often has a river or stream running through the bottom of it.
Vegetation 	Vegetation is a term that refers to all the plants, trees, and greenery that grow in a particular place
Rainforest 	A rainforest is a warm, dense forest that gets a lot of rain all year long because it is so wet and warm, millions of amazing plants, trees, and animals live there.
Amazon 	A major river in South America and the surrounding tropical rainforest basin.
Physical feature 	A physical feature is defined simply as a natural part of the Earth's landscape.
Human feature 	A human feature is anything on our planet that has been made, built, or changed by people.
Atlas 	An atlas is a book of maps. It helps people find different countries, oceans, and places.
Aerial photograph 	An aerial photograph is defined as a picture taken from above that provides a "bird's-eye view" of a landscape.
Fieldwork 	Fieldwork is the practical process of investigating the outdoors.
Comparison 	The act of comparing or the result of being compared.
Map reading 	A landmark or symbol shown on a drawing of an area that helps you know where you are or tells you what a place is like
Deforestation 	Deforestation is the permanent removal or clearing of forests and trees by humans.
